CIRCULAR FOR THE ADOPTION OF WORK PLAN GUIDELINES FOR BASIC EDUCATION AND PRIMARY HEALTHCARE IN NIGER STATE

In our continuous effort to enhance the quality and effectiveness of basic education and primary health care services, we are pleased to announce the adoption of comprehensive budget guidelines designed to provide a coherent framework for planning and resource allocation in these critical sectors.
