- ii. the Programme was jointly conceived and introduced by Presidential Enabling Business Environment Council (PEBEC) and Nigeria Governors Forum (NGF) supported by the World Bank with a facility of \$750Million to support states;
- iii. the State has inaugurated the "State Council on Ease of Doing Business Environment (SEBEC) and the Steering Committee on State Action on Business Enabling Reform (SABER) on Monday 28th November, 2022 following the approval of Mr. Governor of 9th November, 2022;
