

3.1.9 Council, therefore, unanimously approved the memorandum.  
COUNCIL;

**NOTED:**

- a. That the State Action on Business Enabling Reform Action Plan (SABER) programme a Performance-based Intervention under Implementation from year 2023-2025;
- b. The Saber programme seeks to incentivize and strengthen the implementation of business enabling reforms in 36 States plus FCT;
- c. The DLIs focus on steps towards enhancing land administration, business enabling infrastructure, PPP, investment promotion framework and business enabling regulatory environment;
- d. The programme has four eligibility criteria as encapsulated in para. 4.3.7
- e. Participating States that achieve all DLRs would potentially receive a total disbursement of USD 52.3 million between 2023 and 2026.
