1.0 Preface

The engagement session organized by Niger State Investment Promotion Agency in collaboration with SABER Focal Office, Niger State Chamber of Commerce and other key private sector players was held on 18th November, 2025 at YAYI Hotel & Suits Minna. - iv. Capture the challenges faced by the private sector in the state doing business and reflect them as an activity on the 2025 BERAP plan

- v. Foster more synergy between the private sector and Business Enabling Environment MDAs
- vi. Wrap up all the submission and present in a plan for onward submission to SABER

5.0 Discussions on the Activities to be captured in the 2026 BERAP from Focal MDAs

5.1 Niger State Investment Promotion Agency: The agency whose responsibility is to coordinating all investment activities in the state made submissions on the activity area below

- Continuous advocacy on ease of doing business activities
- Organizing regular stakeholder's engagements on access to credit for MSMEs in the state
- Carryout aftercare services and intervene on challenges faced by investors
- Increase private sector participation in the process of policy and institutional reforms
- Monitoring and tracking of inflow of domestic and foreign direct investment

Also, Agencies that share similar activities on the result area are Ministry of lands and Survey, Niger State Geographic Information System, Niger State Internal Revenue Services, Chambers of Commerce, Manufacturers Association of Nigeria, National Association of Small & Medium Scale Entrepreneur, Min. of Finance, Min. of Investment, Min. of Women Affairs
