This guideline is in pursuant to the provisions of the Niger State Urban and Regional Planning Development Board, EdictNo.3of1999 <u>https://nogp.nigerstate.gov.ng/wp-content/uploads/NIGER-STATE-URBAN-DEVELOPMENT-BOARD-BUILDING-REGULATIONS-1999.pdf</u> and <u>https://nogp.nigerstate.gov.ng/storage/NIGER-STATE-URBAN-DEVELOPMENT-BOARD-BUILDING-REGULATIONS-2023-1.pdf</u> The law is domestication of the provisions of Nigerian Urban and Regional Planning Law of 1992.

	Applicants are required to write an application letter, with company letter headed paper, addressed to the General Manager, Niger State Urban Development Board Headquarters: Block Fold Secretariat, Mu'azu Mohammed Road, Minna		
	The process timeline is within one(1)working day		
STAGE 2	Documents Required on Application		
	The following items shall be submitted to the Board:		
	i. A set of A3 coloured copies of Line Drawings showing the proposed route, manhole		
	and base stations of connections.		
	ii. spreadsheet of road distance schedule showing Ring Name/base station ID, Proposed road distance (m), road name (if available), starting and ending coordinate, and		
	proposed man-hole coordinates, should be submitted in both hard and soft copy.		
STAGE 3	Submission of Application Form.		
	No Application Processing Fees		
	 For Manual Submission: Submit the duly completed application form through: nsudb.mx@gmail.com or at the Board's Headquarters Registration Office, Block F Old Secretariat, Mu'azu Mohammed Road, Minna. Application will be provided with a registration reference number The applicant will be issued with acknowledgement letter stating the application reference number and any further requirements. The process above can be achieved within 1workingday 		

STAGE 4	Site Inspection and Reporting				
	• Upon the submission of the application for Right of Way (ROW) permit, the applicant				
	shall arrange and convey our staff (inspectors) for the proposed routes inspection.				
	• Variations from the distance applied for during inspection will be charged accordingly.				
	• <i>Processing timeline is within two (2) working day minimum.</i> The timeline strongly depends on the applicant's readiness to go for the inspection and number of local government areas to cover.				

STAGE 5	Issuance of Right of Way Permit.					
STRUE 2	 Successful applications are assessed and the building/development plan permit fee calculated based on the schedule of fees: <u>https://nogp.nigerstate.gov.ng/storage/NIGER-STATE-TAX-ADMINISTRATION-</u> <u>AND-CONSOLIDATION-LAW-2022.pdf</u> 					
	 Successful applicants are notified through issuance of Demand Notice to pay the permit fee via applicants' email address or hard copies at the designated offices or scanned and sent through WhatsApp if such number is provided. Payments is to be made through; <i>Account Name: Niger State Board of Internal</i> 					
	Revenue, Bank/Account Number: First Bank Plc/2013787716					
	• Evidence of payment for Permit fees shall be submitted to the Board via <u>nsudb.mx@gmail.com</u> or at the Board's Headquarters Registration Office, Block F Old Secretariat, Mu'azu Mohammed Road, Minna.					
	• Issuance of right of way permit will be within three (3) working days from the date submission of evidence of payment for Permit fee by the applicant.					
	• Where all requirements are met, the entire permit process takes ten (10) working					
	days					
	• Applicants are to collect the ROW permit at the Headquarters.					
	• The Board's offices operate between 8:00am and 4:00pm Mondays to Friday except public holidays
